## Open Door Bird Sanctuary VOLUNTEERING

### **Land Stewardship/Gardening**

On call, or regularly scheduled work, doing trail and property maintenance, planting in spring and clean up in the fall.

### **Open Days Team**

ODBS is open to the public on Saturday afternoons during the summer months. We need 8-10 volunteer staff members on open days from 11am to 4pm. Ticket booth, parking director, trail captains, educators, and raptor handlers are jobs to be filled.

### **Educators/Off-site & On-site Programs**

Educators are trained to educate the public on the ODBS birds, raptors here in Door County and WI, and general environmental highlights of ODBS and Door County. Educators volunteer both here at ODBS and on outreach programs when we travel off site with our birds.

### **Raptor Team**

The Raptor Team members are volunteers that have been trained to work directly with the birds of prey here at ODBS. Feeding, cleaning, handling, and training. They are also Educators. To become a Raptor Team member, we ask for three (3) hours per week. As Rob, executive director, is on-site daily arrangements can be made to accommodate your schedule.

This gives the birds time to become comfortable with the new person, the volunteer to become comfortable being in close proximity to the birds. Learn husbandry and handling skills to work with these amazing animals.

### **Construction Team**

Here at the Sanctuary we are always changing and improving bird housing, buildings and other projects. No need to be an expert carpenter. There are tasks for all skill levels. As a bonus Rob is an amazing teacher, and you will take home new building skills.

### **Working Remotely/Miscellaneous**

We need administrators for our Facebook page, web-site, and any other social media ideas. Outreach to the community to schedule and set-up raptor programs, non-profit tax experience, send thank you letters, tax deductible receipts.
