personalized private tour of the sanctuary!**

Private tours are available all year round. It's a great way to visit ODBS for groups of 1 to 20 people. Tour times are 10am, 1pm and 4pm April-Oct and 10am and 1pm Nov-March. They are daily and need to be scheduled in advance to reserve your date and time.

A private tour is a behind the scenes visit to ODBS. You'll meet and learn about all the birds at the sanctuary, some of them up close and personal, outside of their aviaries. Next we'll visit the Bird Care Center, where you'll learn about food preparation, and we'll get some snacks ready for our resident raptors. Then it's back outdoors, where adults on the tour will have the opportunity to feed some of the raptors in their aviaries. From there we'll head to the Nature and Education Center, where we have lots of "hands on" learning artifacts, awesome ODBS caps and shirts, and additional literature on ODBS and Door County. Special for the kids, we have cool educational activity packs for them to take along, inspiring more learning about birds of prey.

A private tour lasts about 1 ½ to 2 hours. The tour fee is \$60 for groups up to 4, and \$12 per additional person if there are more than 4 in your group. Kids 4 and under are always free! When you visit for a private tour, the sanctuary is reserved just for your group during that time.
